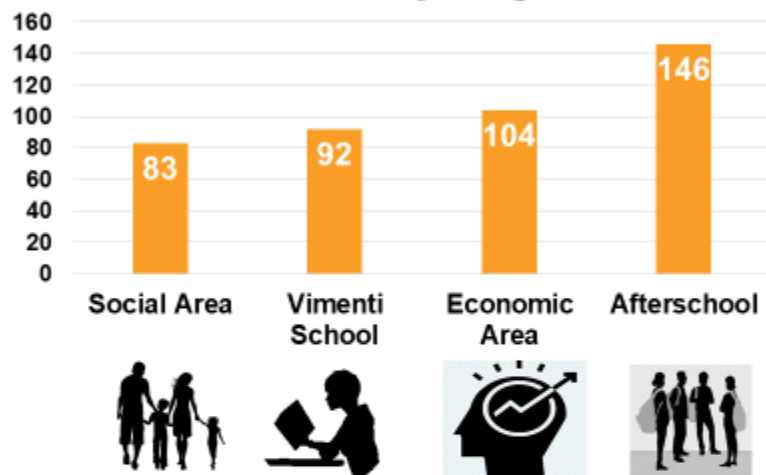

Services for Families

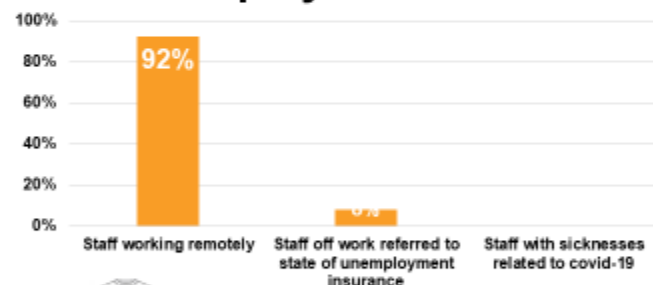
- Vimenti School held its grade promotion ceremonies from June 2 to 4 under tents installed in the Vimenti parking lot, within the Ernesto Ramos Antonini.
- A total of 33 students received their kindergarten diploma, while 58 first and second grade students were promoted to the next grade.
- A total of 201 people were served by Vimenti during May 2020.
- Food Program started to serve members on a daily basis.
- Weekly average services:**
 - Case managements – 166
 - Economic Mentorships - 49
 - Postsecondary programs – 35
 - Educational Program - 35

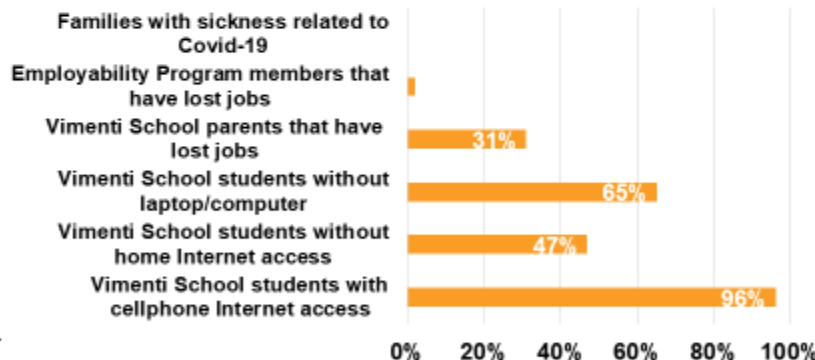

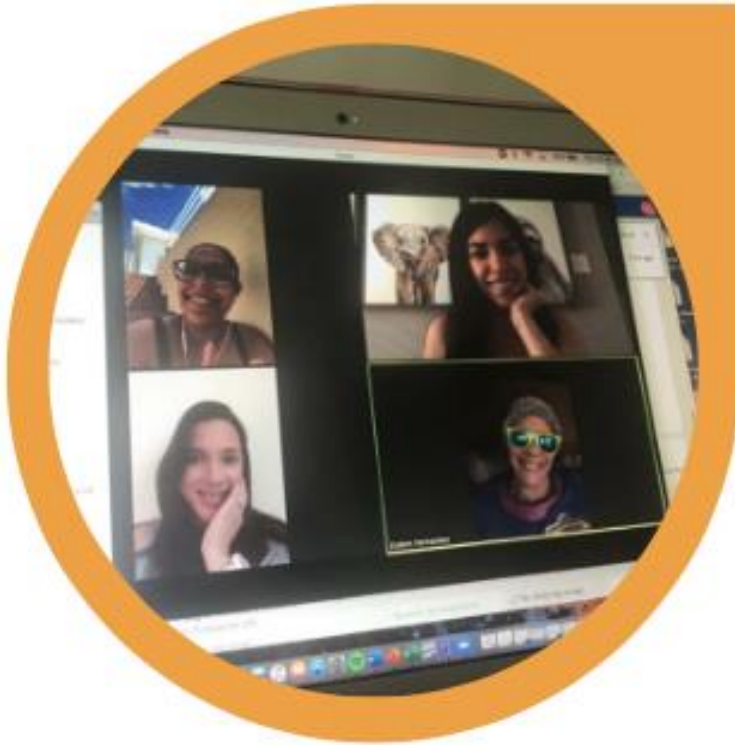

Safety Protocols

- **The Safety and Contagious Diseases Prevention Protocol Plan**
- Aware of the importance of safety and protection measures for all, we developed protocols and protection measures for our personnel, as well as our participants and families.
 - Screening Survey before activation

 - Protection Measures

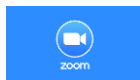
Distance Learning

Long distance learning:

- Enrollment 126 students (K-3)
- Scheduled classes and support services
- 5-6 hours daily of instructional time

Resources

- 126 Ipads with connectivity in alliance with T-Mobile
- Online distance learning platforms and meeting rooms
- Manipulatives and instructional materials for each student
- Books, workbooks and notebooks for each student



Vimenti virtual learning

Zoom is the preferred video conferencing tool for Vimenti teachers to work with groups and individual students.

Seesaw is the selected platform for providing standards and curriculum-aligned student tasks and activities. The system has communication and formative assessment features that are essential to Vimenti's needs.

Reading A to Z is a program providing leveled texts in both Spanish and English. Texts are available in multiple formats (print, digital, projectable) for use in whole-group, small-group, and individual instruction and independent reading. Accounts were purchased for each teacher to create class and student accounts.

The Houghton Mifflin Into Reading, ¡Arriba la Lectura!, Into Math, and ¡Arriba las Matemáticas! programs provide a comprehensive approach to dual language instruction with a wide range of teacher and student resources to draw from in both print and digital formats.

Boom Cards are a digital tool for teachers to create engaging, self-grading exercises for students to complete. Vimenti teachers adapt and create tasks that align to the focus standards and curriculum.

✓ **Other resources:**

- ✓ **Digital magazine** to promote health and balance life.
- ✓ **Tu Bienestar Vimenti** – A first response line to channel health and emotional problems of our families focusing on prevention and orientations. Our Pediatricians will be available for online consultation.
- ✓ **New online experiences** – Yoga, Salsa and Zumba lessons
- ✓ **Employability and Entrepreneurship Programs** supporting displaced from work adults. Six participants were employed (placement confirmed) through the special MOU with *Supermax*
- ✓ **Families boot-camp** – Annual orientation for families
